RE: Conductor Training Course.

I am pleased to advise that you have satisfied your instructors with respect to the initial training in Tramway Operations as a “**CONDUCTOR**”, and forward herewith is your “Trainee Authorisation/Record Card” endorsed as **Conductor-Grade 1**.

Under the terms and conditions laid down by the Board of Directors relative to crew training and Tramway Operations, this Authorisation entitles you to undertake “on-road” training as a Tram Conductor during normal traffic periods, subject to the following:

- 1) .Approval of the Officer in Charge and the Tram Crew as rostered on the day is sought and gained;
- 2) Direct supervision of your training is carried out by a Driver Grade 5, Driver Grade 6 or an instructor;
- 3) You are permitted to act as an *Assistant Conductor* during this period.

At the conclusion of the time stipulated elsewhere for “on-road” training and the minimum number of trips, you are invited to submit your record card to the Training and Assessment Committee. Upon satisfactory passing any such verbal, written and practical examinations as may be deemed necessary, your name will be submitted to the Board of Directors for approval as Conductor Grade 2N.
