TITLE: SECURING TRAM DRIVING TOOLS

DATE OF OPERATION: 29/01/2016

DETAILS OF NOTICE:

There have been a number of recent instances of visitors interfering with tramcar equipment when trams are left standing at Railway Square Waiting Shed.

This includes removing driving tools from where they are stowed, turning off compressor switches, and turning destination signs.

In future all driver's tools and punches are to be locked in the cupboard at Railway Square Waiting Shed.

In addition all Traffic Staff should be vigilant whilst trams are left standing at Railway Square Waiting Shed to ensure visitors do not interfere with tramcar controls and equipment.

A 4B key opens the cupboard and for those who do not possess a 4B key, one of the First Aid kits has one on the key ring. I will endeavour to obtain another for the second First Aid kit.
