TRAFFIC / SAFETY NOTICE

STM Traffic / Safety Notice No. 1602

TITLE: STABLING OF TRAMCARS ON TRAMWAY AVENUE

DATE OF OPERATION: 16/ 05 /2016

DETAILS OF NOTICE:

Due to a tram than ran away after being parked on Tramway Avenue at Cross Street the following instructions **MUST** be followed:

1. **ALL** trams must be stabled on the flat area beside the Rly Square Waiting Shed;
2. **ALL** trams **MUST** be chocked correctly;
3. **ALL** trams **MUST** have the **HANDBRAKE** applied to the leading end of the car.
4. If trams are to be parked on the grade in Tramway Avenue the following **MUST** be adhered to:
 - a) The **TRAM MUST** be **CHOCKED**;
 - b) The **HANDBRAKE MUST** be applied; and
 - c) **THE CREW MUST NOT LEAVE THE TRAM UNATTENDED AT ANY TIME WHILST IT IS PARKED ON THE GRADE.**
5. Traffic Staff also need to be aware when releasing the handbrake as it may cause injuries.
