## TRAFFIC / SAFETY NOTICE

STM Traffic / Safety Notice No. 1605

**TITLE: TRAMCARS TRAVELLING IN CONVOY ON STM SITE**

**DATE OF OPERATION:** 22/ 05 /2016

**DETAILS OF NOTICE:**

When travelling in convoy, there are two important things that tram crews **MUST** remember:

1. When running in convoy with one or more other tramcars, the minimum distance to be kept between the tramcars is:
  - Three span poles (approximately 90 metres) for main line running; or
  - Three car lengths (slow speeds within museum area); and
  - If the tracks are greasy, more distance **MUST** be left between the trams.
2. When travelling on the Royal National Park line, in any direction, tram crews are **NOT** to drive in parallel at any time.
