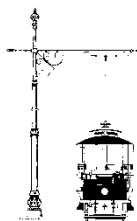

TRAFFIC / SAFETY NOTICE

STM Traffic / Safety Notice No. 1803

TITLE: REOPENING OF ARMY HILL AND NORTH TERMINUS

DATE OF OPERATION: 9/04/2018

DETAILS OF NOTICE:

To notify all Traffic and Workshop staff that Army Hill and North terminus is now available for normal traffic.

FULL PARALLEL is to be used when ascending the hill and the tram MUST stop at the Army crossing when descending the hill.

There are yellow lines showing the level area beside the platform.

The first trip of the day is to ensure the track is clear of debris and to open the southern gate. The driver MUST remain in the tram whilst the Observer or conductor opens the gates.

At the end of the day the crew MUST ensure the southern gate is closed and follow the same procedures as above.
