STM Traffic / Safety Notice No. 2006

TITLE: BEWARE OF SURROUNDINGS ON OPERATING DAYS.

DATE OF OPERATION: 24/07/2020

DETAILS OF NOTICE:

As the reopening of the Museum will occur shortly, ALL Traffic and Works staff MUST be aware of their surroundings when operating any trams on site.

With virtually no trams operating on the museum system over the past 4 or so months and with trackwork occurring in Tramway Avenue on the western track, tram crews are reminded to be alert for any obstacles which may be near or on the tramlines. This also applies to the yard where road vehicles may be parked.

If an incident occurs, the crew will be immediately stood down until the incident is investigated.

SO BE ALERT when operating a tram.

Also, anyone who parks a road vehicle near the tram tracks should ensure that it will NOT be hit by a passing tram.
