5. When working on coupled set of tramcars, which conductor is the Conductor in charge?
6. Where are the compulsory stops on the Sutherland line?
7. Describe the Safeworking system(s) on the Museum tramway.
8. What is the procedure for paying in excess cash during a shift?
9. Where a Starter is on duty, what special precautions must the Conductor observe before giving the proceed signal to the Driver?
10. When a family with more than two children visit the Museum, what special entry fee arrangement apply?
11. When working on footboard (“toastrack”) type trams, what special precautions should the Conductor be aware of?
12. What is the policy regarding animals on site?
