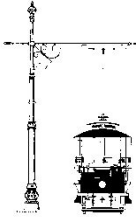

STM Traffic / Safety Notice No. 2103

TITLE: Western track tramway Ave between Pitt St and Scissors crossover now available for traffic.

DATE OF OPERATION: 20/02/2021

DETAILS OF NOTICE:

Following the completion of concreting the '4 foot' of the Western Track of Tramway Ave, this track is now available for traffic and 'up + down' running will resume from 21/02/2021.

Stopping in this section should be avoided, and if a stop is required, conductors should ensure that passengers do not alight on the eastern side of the tram as the 6 foot has not been concreted and is partially excavated.
