RE: Tram Driver Training Course.

The Training and Assessment Committee is pleased to acknowledge that you have progressed in the Tram Driver Training Course to the stage where you have satisfied the Instructors and Examiners with respect to practical and verbal examination in tram driving.

This final stage of your training scheme for the purpose of obtaining an authorisation from the Board of Directors to operate the Society's tramcars is to pass a written examination. This examination has been given to and will be given to all members undertaking tram driver training. It is urged that you treat this examination seriously and complete it as set out below to the best of your ability.

As you have now completed the mandatory number of training runs on passenger trams in traffic to a satisfactory standard, please answer the enclosed exam.

The Examination

A total of twenty (20) questions have been set and candidates are expected to attempt all questions. Answers should be numbered to correspond with the questions, be typed or written in a legible manner and be of approximately one half (1/2) A4 sheet in length. Grammatical accuracy will not be a major importance.

The Examiners

Three members of the Training and Assessment Committee, will independently mark each paper. Then these marks will be considered by the Examiners in Committee.

Examination Numbers

You are asked to identify your answer sheets by the Candidate Number entered below. In this way, a non biased result may be achieved in awarding marks.

Marking

Each Examiner will be authorised to mark each question "Pass" or "Fail". A total of 45 or more "Pass" results will acknowledge that the candidate has passed the examination without further comment. Where the total is between 30 and 44 "Pass" results, the Examination subcommittee will examine the results in detail before forming an opinion. If the candidate receives less than 30 "Pass" marks, then this will normally indicate that the examination candidate does not have sufficient grasp of the fundamental ideas and should be asked to undertake further tuition.
